

7 Also they teach that one holy Church will continue forever. The Church is the congregation of saints, in which the Gospel is correctly taught and the Sacraments are rightly administered.

And for the true unity of the Church it is enough to agree about the teaching of the Gospel and the administration of the Sacraments. It is not necessary that human traditions, that is, rites or ceremonies, instituted by men, should be the same everywhere. But Paul says: "One faith, one Baptism, one God and Father of all", etc. Eph. 4:5,6.

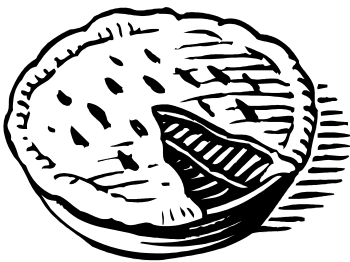
