- EDU8112 Health and Safety in the Early Childhood Centers
  - Planning for safety, first aid, health, and nutrition in the early childhood learning environment.
- EDU8508 Strategies for Teaching Reading Comprehension
  - Demonstration of strategies that will help students comprehend what they read.
- ENG8604 Conflict Management and Resolution
